Golf Guidelines provide a phased approach to unite all stakeholders in the golf industry under the same mission: safety. COVID-19 is a highly dynamic, global pandemic. Our owners, operators, superintendents, and professionals benefit from one unified source of information for best practices regarding safe operation of a golf course during this crisis. Golf Guidelines is dynamic and is constantly updated to provide the golf industry with the latest, most relevant information.

PHASED APPROACH

Phase I: Operating under maximum safety. Implement Car-to-Car procedure to enable safe play on the golf course. Hole liners are modified to limit possibilities of germ transmission. Groups are limited to 2 golfers. Practice facilities are closed.

Phase II: Maintain Car-to-Car procedure to continue safe play on the golf course. Begin implementing restricted operations of practice facilities.

Phase V: Restaurants and practice facilities are open with minimum restrictions, as defined by local governance and management. PPE restrictions lifted by local governance and management.

Phase III: Begin allowing players to play in groups of 3-4 while maintaining social distancing protocols. Reintroduce food service and beverage cart service as capacity, and local governance, allow. Open golf shop in limited capacity at this time, with proper PPE as defined by the CDC.



Phase IV: Reopen the golf shop, restaurants and ease restrictions on practice facilities. Groups may choose to ride in golf cars with 2 persons if they wish. Staggered arrival times are no longer necessary from a maintenance standpoint.
